SENIOR'S FACILITIES & SERVICES

Mayerthorpe offers a range of senior living options, including Extendicare, independent living, and senior supportive living facilities. Seniors in these residences have access to valuable resources through the Town's Family and Community Support Services (FCSS), Seniors Outreach Program.

This program is designed to connect seniors with the services they need, tailored to their individual requirements. We provide information on various seniors' programs and benefits offered by Federal, Provincial, and Municipal governments, and assist in accessing these programs. Our team is available to help navigate any challenges that may arise when dealing with government departments.

Additionally, we offer FREE income tax preparation for seniors with low income, with no age restriction, and can assist with filling out necessary forms or paperwork. For transportation, the Seniors Taxi operates free of charge every Friday, while the West End Bus Program offers transportation and excursions to seniors in Mayerthorpe and the surrounding region.

WATER & WASTE MANAGEMENT

The Town of Mayerthorpe is committed to providing modern and efficient municipal services to meet the needs of today and prepare for tomorrow's growth. Our Water-treatment Plant, Sewer-Lift Station, and Lagoon have all been upgraded.

Residents benefit from weekly garbage pick-up, bi-weekly recycling and seasonal compost facilities

The Town also has a Bottle Depot for recycling, a Hazardous Waste Depot for those looking to dispose of items responsible. Spring and Fall Clean-up events take place as a larger-scale community clean-up effort.
