Impacting Mayerthorpe Utility Bills



Due to the ongoing Canada Post labour disruption, some Town of Mayerthorpe services may be affected. November 2024 utility bills will still be mailed in the first week of December. However, customers who typically receive their bills via regular mail may experience delays depending on the duration of the labour dispute. **Despite the strike, utility bills are still due, and residents are reminded that not receiving a bill does not mean there is no payment due.**
