BYLAW NO. 1041

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MAYERTHORPE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND CERTAIN SECTIONS OF BYLAW NO. 855 BEING THE HAWKERS AND PEDDLERS BYLAW

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto, provides that a Council of a Municipality may by Bylaw control and regulate business, business activities and persons engaged in business within the municipality and provide for a system of licenses permits or approvals for same, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Mayerthorpe directs that Bylaw No. 855 Hawkers and Peddlers Bylaw be amended.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Mayerthorpe, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

THAT Bylaw No. 855 Hawkers and Peddlers Bylaw of the Town of Mayerthorpe be amended as follows:

SECTION 1

6. **Local Non-Profit Group** – means a community group from Mayerthorpe or area, incorporated under the Societies Act of Alberta that distributes funds to provide services to the community or their members.

SECTION 3

7. No person shall, within the Town, carry on or operate any business as a Hawker or Peddler within 50 metres of businesses selling same or similar goods.
8. All Local Non-Profit Groups shall be exempt from this Bylaw. Hawker or Peddler authorized to operate under the umbrella of Local Non-Profit Groups operating, on public lands under the direction and control of the Town, are deemed to have express consent of Council to operate on the public lands.
9. Hawker or Peddler shall not operate on public lands under the direction and control of the Town, only exception pursuant to Section 3, Item 8 of this Bylaw.

Hawkers and Peddlers Annual License	\$150.00/year

SCHEDULE 'C'

Penalties:

Failure to Obtain a Hawkerc and Peddlers License.	\$200.00 plus cost of license
Parking on Town streets in excess of prescribed hours.	\$250.00
Operating within 50 metres of a business selling same or similar items.	\$250.00
Operating on public lands without written permission.	\$250.00
2 nd and Subsequent Offences of any of the above.	\$500.00

Should any provision of this Bylaw be found to be invalid then such invalid provision shall be severed and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.

This Bylaw comes into effect on the date of final passing.


